Timing is everything: We find it's best to start the music 30-minutes after your event is scheduled to start. That allows everyone time to arrive and get settled in for the show. It's also best to serve snacks after the show. It's too hard to clap, sing, eat and drink all at once!

Don't be shy: While it's exciting for kids to see live musicians perform, it's even more exciting when the grownups are engaged and a part of the show. The more you sing, clap and move to the music, the more they'll enjoy the experience. Remember, there is no such thing as a bad voice when you're singing for kids!
